It is striking to see how little interest and few publications have been devoted to the **Lumbo-sacral plexuses and their branches**.

Of course, the number of cases is largely inferior to the multitude of cases of Brachial plexus injuries. However, the main reasons of this lack of exposure are the difficulty of a precise diagnosis and the complexity of the repair with approaches varying with the level of the affected roots.

The lack of several large series does not allow to evaluate the results of the repairs. Very few surgeons have this experience and we felt that the gathering of interested professionals (anatomists, neurologists, physiotherapists and surgeons) would allow a better comprehension of this pathology.

We will be discussing the approaches and their pitfalls, strategy, methods of repair and results.

In a second part, we will also discuss the repair of the distal branches: Sciatic nerve and its branches, in view of the new techniques.
